

2022 Community Needs Survey

Overview & Summary of Results

Objective:

The Community Needs Assessment Survey was administered with the purpose of gaining a better understanding of how the district can make the Bondurant-Farrar schooling experience as positive and impactful as possible. This type of survey is conducted every five years.

Approach:

The survey, 29 questions in length, consisted primarily of multiple choice questions with two being open ended. This created an opportunity for Bondurant-Farrar stakeholders to provide anonymous feedback regarding their perspectives and experiences.


Results:


The survey was offered for a three week period, opening on October 17, 2022 and closing on November 7, 2022. During this time, 476 community stakeholders completed the survey




What school buildings do your children currently attend?





The Board of Education seeks citizens' input regarding school needs, topics, and issues.


Citizens have adequate opportunities to participate in school policy and program development.






How often do you attend school board meetings in a school year?


Do you usually vote in BFCSD school board elections?







When scheduling no school days so that staff can participate in professional development, what is your preference?










The district provides programs to meet students' academic needs.













How often do you attend fine arts, athletic, or any BFCSD event throughout the year?









How supportive are you of constructing a new school that would initially serve as an early childhood center (grades PK-K), and designed for future additions to later serve additional students?




How supportive are you of constructing varsity baseball and softball fields (one each) at the high school campus?







From which of the following sources do you CURRENTLY get most of your information about the school district and/or your child's school? 476 responses



From which of the following sources would you PREFER to get most of your information about the school district and/or your child's school? 476 responses









Do you receive sufficient information about your child's academic performance?
