SENIOR RELEASE

Seniors who have a minimum 2.50 GPA as determined by Junior Year grades, are in good standing with the school, are enrolled in five or more classes, have a minimum of Thirty-six (36) earned credits at the start of 1st semester/minimum forty-two (42) credits earned at the start of 2nd semester, and will have or will be meeting minimum graduation requirements, will be permitted to leave school for Senior Release. Seniors are required to return a signed permit from their parents for this privilege (Board Policy form 501.11E). All seniors are required to enroll in a minimum of five (5) classes with at least three (3) at Bondurant-Farrar. Seniors are also required to meet their Physical Education requirement, unless otherwise exempted as per Iowa Code. Students taking classes under the Post-Secondary Enrollment Option Act may be exempted from this five (5)-period requirement.

Senior students may be allowed to leave for the following reasons: classes off campus or have completed the required five or more classes. This release may be revoked if the student does not follow the guidelines or does not meet the qualifications for senior release.
