SENIOR RELEASE

- 1. Students must be classified as a senior (minimum of thirty-six (36) credits at the start of the 1st semester/minimum forty-two (42) credits at the start of 2nd semester) and be taking enough credits to meet graduation requirements).
- 2. Seniors must be enrolled in a minimum of five classes, with at least three of them at Bondurant-Farrar.
- 3. Students must maintain a minimum of 2.50 G.P.A, as determined by previous semester grades.
- 4. Students must obtain approval from their parent/guardian, the counselor, and the principal or designee. This release may also be revoked at any time by parent/guardian/counselor/principal or designee.
- 5. Students must follow behavior guidelines. Academic, tardiness, absence and discipline problems may be sufficient reason to revoke this release.
- 6. When students return early they are to report to the office and sign in. This senior release may be revoked if student is in the halls during class time without permission.
- 7. Seniors are not allowed to take students who do not have release time with them. Senior release will be revoked if this occurs.
