

STUDENT FUND RAISING

At the beginning of each school year, a list of all fund-raising to be conducted by school sponsored extra-curricular programs will be submitted to the Activities Director and Building Principal for approval. Any additions during the school year, will be submitted to the Activities Director and Building Principal for approval.

No member of the student body shall be permitted to solicit funds or sell merchandise within the school or representing the school without the express authorization of the sponsor and the principal.

All approved fund raisers will be identified on the District website.

If food products are sold during the school day, those products must meet the nutrition standards of the Healthy Kids Act.

Raffles must follow Iowa Gaming Laws pertaining to raffles. To allow adequate time for approval, raffles must be submitted at least 30 days in advance of any sales.
