INDIVIDUALIZED INSTRUCTION

The board's primary responsibility in the management of the school district is the operation and delivery of the regular educational program. Generally, students attending the school district will receive the regular educational program offered by the district. Only in exceptional circumstances will the board approve students receiving individualized instruction at the expense of the school district.

Recommendations from the superintendent/designee for individualized instruction will state the need for the instruction, the objectives and goals sought for the instruction, the employee requirements for the instruction, the implementation procedures for the instruction, and the evaluation procedures and processes that will be used to assess the value of the instruction.

It will be the responsibility of the superintendent to develop administrative regulations for individualized instruction.
