PROGRAM FOR AT-RISK STUDENTS

The board recognizes some students require additional assistance in order to graduate from the regular education program. The superintendent/designee will provide a plan to encourage and provide an opportunity for at-risk students to achieve their potential and obtain their high school diploma.

It will be the responsibility of the superintendent/designee to develop a plan for students at-risk, which provides for identifying students, for program evaluation, and for the training of employees.
