

## INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE STUDENTS

International exchange students must meet all district entrance requirements including age, place of residence and immunization. International exchange students must be approved by the Board of Education. The board reserves the right to limit the number of international exchange students accepted.

Requesting agencies must submit a student application and résumé to the high school principal or counselor prior to July 15 for the academic year of proposed attendance. International exchange students will pay normal expenses such as lunch tickets and activity tickets. Book and lab fees will be waived for all approved international exchange students.

Students who are citizens of a foreign country will be considered residents if they meet the following requirements:

- The student resides with his/her host family in the Bondurant-Farrar School District;
- The student is in the United States with appropriate documentation (Form I-20) from the United States Department of Justice-Immigration and Naturalization Services;
- The student is a participant in a recognized international exchange program; and,
- The student is physically able to attend school and has provided the school district with such proof, including a current TB test.
